The hospital's charges are the same for all patients, but a patient's responsibility may vary, depending on payment plans negotiated with individual health insurers. Uninsured or underinsured patients should consult with our admitting and billing staff to determine whether they qualify for discounts. These prices are correct as of January 1, 2009.

Emergency Department Charges

Emergency Department charges are based on the level of emergency care provided to our patients. The levels, with level 1 representing basic emergency care, reflect the type of accommodations needed, the personnel resources, the intensity of care and the amount of time needed to provide treatment. The following charges do not include fees for drugs, supplies or additional ancillary procedures that may be required for a particular emergency treatment. They also do not include fees for Emergency Department physicians, who will bill separately for their services.

PATIENT BILLING INFORMATION

Thank you for choosing Doctors Hospital Nelsonville for your healthcare needs. The following is a summary of our billing practices.

Costs and billing

You will get a copy of your hospital bill a few weeks after your hospital stay. You also may get other bills from your doctor(s), including your family doctor or specialists.

Costs of healthcare services are available from Patient Financial Services (first floor, off the main lobby).

We know that for us to correctly manage your hospital bill is important. If you have any questions about charges, please call Patient Accounts at (740) 753-1931.

If your insurance plan does not pay the bill within 90 days, or your claim is denied, you will receive a statement from Doctors indicating the bill is now your responsibility. All bills sent to you are due upon receipt.

Doctors Hospital Nelsonville does not charge interest on any amount not paid in full during the normal course of collection.

Financial assistance

We are pleased to offer financial assistance to patients with limited resources and inadequate medical insurance coverage. Eligibility is determined by total family income/assets. The patient must agree to apply for other assistance available to pay hospital charges (Medicaid, Medicare) before being discharged.
