Explanation of Procedures

Colonoscopy

A routine fiber optic examination of the entire length of the colon from the anus to the ileal-cecal junction. This exam is used to diagnose and treat various disorders of the lower GI tract including polyps (a common precursor to colon cancer), tumors, diverticulosis, irritable bowel disorders, colitis, infections and ischemic portions of bowel (lack of blood supply). Requires a preparatory colon cleansing the day prior to the exam. This examination is performed using conscious sedation agents for patient comfort. Recommended for all persons over age 50 as a baseline for proper colon health.

Esophagogastroduodenoscopy (EGD):

This is a fiber optic examination of the esophagus, stomach and duodenum. This test is used to diagnose and determine treatment for a range of disorders including GERD, gastric reflux, ulcers, esophageal strictures and narrowings. This examination is performed using conscious sedation agents for patient comfort.

Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangiopancreatography (ERCP):

This test is the direct visualization and treatment via the endoscope or duodenoscope to treat blockages and narrowings of the common bile duct and pancreatic duct. This examination is performed using conscious sedation agents for patient comfort.

Endoscopic Ultrasound (EUS):

This test includes the direct visualization of and the ability to obtain specimens from the pancreas and common bile ducts. Involves the use of specialized endoscopes that have ultrasound capabilities to detect and stage different types of tumors. This examination is performed using conscious sedation agents for patient comfort.
