The Hospice Music Program

The Hospice Music Program was established in 2012 with generous funding from Epstein Teicher Philanthropies. The beautiful tones of their harps, dulcimers and guitars serve to ease the transition into death and help to soothe grieving family members as well.

The Epstein Teicher Palliative Care Program

Also established through a grant from Epstein Teicher Philanthropies, the palliative care program seeks to fill in the cracks in the continuity of care typically provided by traditional payer sources. Persons suffering a chronic illness often need care between acute episodes when Medicare or insurance authorizations run out or when hospice is not yet appropriate. Continued care, in fact, has been shown to reduce acute episodes requiring hospitalization, not to mention anguish and suffering. Our palliative care staff has continued to provide services, based on the highly successful team approach model used in hospice, to more than a dozen clients with chronic disease who are no longer eligible for insurance payments, but who are still in need of services.

The Veterans and Commemorative Gardens

Celebrate the life of a loved one by purchasing an engraved commemorative brick to be installed in the walkways of either our Veteran's Garden or our Commemorative Garden.
