Walk-In Primary Care

Doctors Hospital Community Care (DHCC) is a walk-in primary care clinic that provides access to primary care services for patients with or without a medical home. Our aim is to bridge care through addressing low-acuity needs, treating chronic conditions, screening for and intervening on social determinants of health, and linking patients into primary care.

DHCC opened July 2024 as a collaboration between Doctors Hospital Graduate Medical Education (GME) Family Medicine and Internal Medicine Programs to improve Health Equity within our community.

Quick statistics for those served by Community Care:

- 87% self-pay
- 41% under-represented groups
- 27% non-English speakers
- 65% without a primary care provider
- 60% live within 6 miles of DH
