Geriatric Medicine Rotations All blocks equal 4-weeks

Practice of Geriatrics - Central Ohio Geriatrics—A longitudinal, comprehensive experience that includes the basics of geriatrics with fundamental considerations towards patient care and community health initiatives in local elderly populations. Fellows will provide care at central Ohio Geriatrics skilled nursing facilities in the Columbus and surrounding area.

John J. Gerlach Center for Senior Health (2 blocks)—Offers exposure to a continuity panel of long term care (LTC) patients and block experience in skilled rehabilitation, unit patient care, and wellness.

Grant Inpatient Geriatric Consults (2.5 blocks)—A longitudinal rotation providing training and experience in providing geriatric consultation services to patients in a hospital setting.

MedOne Hospital Physicians (1 block) - Offers exposure to LTC patients from an acute standpoint system wide. Fellows will rotate directly alongside post-acute physicians within various environments.

Podiatry/Wound Care (1 block) – The purpose of the wound care experience is to provide the geriatric medicine fellow with the knowledge and skills to: identify patients at risk for development of wounds and wound complications, prescribe preventive measures to promote skin integrity and to treat wound problems once they develop.

Riverside Inpatient Psychiatry (1 block) – Offers exposure to psychiatric illnesses affecting older adults in inpatient consultation setting.

Grant Outpatient Psychiatry (1 block) – Offers exposure to psychiatric illnesses affecting older adults in outpatient consultation setting.

Palliative Care (2 blocks) – Provides exposure to a variety of models of palliative care in the inpatient and outpatient settings.

Hospice Kobacker (1 block) - Exposure to a variety of models of hospice and palliative care, in the inpatient and outpatient settings
