Notable Features of the New Unit

- The new NICU has doubled in total care space to 42 beds (26 single and eight double occupancy rooms).
- Double occupancy rooms feature a larger family waiting area, increased storage and an improved overall family experience that allows for more privacy for moms and families. They also serve to allow twins to share a room.

Details About the New Family Suites

- Pull-out sofa so parents can spend the night with their baby
- Small refrigerator for moms to store breast milk
- Television
- Controls for room lighting and temperature
- Comfortable chairs to allow for skin-on-skin "Kangaroo Care" between parents and babies
- Private breast pumps in the single occupancy rooms
- Bright and inviting natural light in each room with blackout curtains to ensure babies are able to sleep
