What to Bring

On the day of your appointment, please remember to bring the following:

- + Photo ID
- + Health insurance card(s)
- + Copayment
- + All of your medication in original bottles
- + All available medical records and test results

Scheduling

We value you and your time. We will make every effort to stay on schedule; however, there is always the possibility of an emergency, which could delay your appointment. **Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your appointment to complete any necessary paperwork.** If you need to cancel an appointment, please contact our office as soon as possible, preferably 24 to 48 business hours before your visit.

What to Expect from Your Office Visit

After you've completed your paperwork, your physician will:

- + Begin the physical exam
- + Review any test results
- + Discuss your individualized plan of care with you

If office testing is required, we can usually provide testing on the same day as your visit. Stress tests, stress echocardiograms, and any hospital testing and procedures will need to be scheduled for a later date.

After You Go Home from Surgery

After your surgery, you will receive discharge instructions from the hospital staff. Please call your physician's office with any questions about your instructions.

For Family Members and Caregivers

Patients undergoing noninvasive diagnostic tests typically need little or no assistance after their procedure. For more extensive tests and procedures, patients will receive instructions on how family members or caregivers can help speed the recovery process.
